



DBKK Nyhedsbrev December 2020 (english below)

2. **Blocs & Walls:** During the current closure we have grabbed the chance to exchange and build new climbing routes, so that we have an exciting offering ready when we re-open. In collaboration with DIF/DK1aF/Team Copenhagen we have also been able to give our elite climbers the possibility to continue their training under certain restrictions,

3. **Sundholm:** Also, in Sundholm we use the opportunity to upgrade our walls (through quiet some renovation of some of the old wall plates) as well as to build some new routes.

4. **Amager Bakke:** We are so lucky to be able to keep Amager Bakke open for both multi-pitch and single-pitch activities. Keep an eye on the Facebook postings in the DBKKs FB group on when the different openings take place (under section activities). Thanks a lot (!) to the around 20 volunteers who help us to make this offering possible.

5. **New climbing wall:** as approved in the last general meeting for our members, we continue to work with the establishment of a new wall, which now entails to create a fire escape strategy.
